His clinical profile areas are bladder and bowel management, sexual function and pain in SCI patients, as well as syringomyelia. He has been the director of the Department of Rehabilitation Medicine at Linköping University Hospital since 2012 and was elected as president of NoSCoS in 2017. He was among the initiators and course leaders of NASCIR (Nordic Advanced Spinal Cord Injury Rehabilitation Course) and is responsible for Swedish SCI course for Residents in PMR.
